

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

OF THE

CITY OF GRANADA, MARTIN COUNTY MINNESOTA.

REGULATING THE INSTALLATION OF WATER METERS AND HOOK-UP CHARGES

Be it resolved by the City Council of Granada Minnesota of Martin County that all house water services be metered, which is served by the City water system.

Where as all meters installed must be purchased from the city to keep meters uniform in the city.

Where as the service charge for water and sewage hook-up will be time and material with meter installed at the same time.

Where as property owner paying for water meter, pipe from main to water meter using 3/4" type K copper tubing.

Where as the labor to install, backhoe, labor of operator on back-hoe, labor for tapping main, shall be paid for by the property owner.

Where as the sanitary hook-up shall be in accordance with resolution #2 governing the installation of the hook-ups to the city sanitation system.

Now therefore be it resolved by the City Council of Granada that this resolution #6 shall take effect upon its adoption by the City Council on the 3rd day of May 19 77.
